Freezing temperatures spread across a wide area of Southern California, Arizona, Texas and Mexico the night of Feb. 3-4, 2011 with temperatures hitting as low as 18 degrees. This has had a huge effect on supplies of bananas, citrus, salads and lettuces, and items such as peppers, tomatoes, zucchini, cucumbers and winter squashes.

As always, we will do our best to provide you with the finest quality fresh organic produce available, but it's important to understand that because of the severity of this freeze and the breadth of products that are affected, we expect to see limited availability, higher pricing, and smaller sizing on many key items. All reports are pointing to 1957 as the last time a freeze hit this hard in these growing regions.
